



# Washington State GAMBLING COMMISSION

*Protect the public by ensuring that gambling is legal and honest.*

The Washington State Gambling Commission (WSGC) is recruiting for a full-time Agent in Charge of the Tribal Gaming Unit. This position and the Special Agents they oversee are limited jurisdiction law enforcement officers and are exempt from state civil service rules.

## **What you will be doing**

As a valued member of our agency's leadership team, you will be at the forefront of a rapidly evolving industry partnering with Tribal Gaming Agencies to ensure gambling is legal and honest.

The Agent in Charge has four direct reports, three Special Agent Supervisors and an administrative assistant. In addition, the Unit has 13 Special Agents throughout Washington.

The Agent in Charge of the Tribal Gaming Unit is responsible for:

- Developing and managing the co-regulatory program with the Tribal Gaming Agencies operating 29 tribal casinos to ensure operations are compliant with their respective Tribal-State Compact;
- Participating in Tribal-State Compact negotiations;
- Recommending changes to Tribal-State Compacts through Memorandums of Understanding and Appendix Revisions;
- Managing the agency's quarterly tribal billing to recoup the Unit's regulatory costs incurred;
- Coordinating numerous work groups with tribes, Tribal Gaming Agencies, and internal staff;
- Evaluating and approving gaming technology to determine compliance with Tribal-State Compacts; and
- Managing the Unit's administrative and criminal investigations of gambling activities or associated crimes.
